A Trust Fund set up by the Government under the Commission on Poverty in 2013 to tackle poverty and social exclusion, and foster well-being and cohesion of the society through social innovation and entrepreneurship












## **Overview of Funded Projects**





- ➤ Total Approved Funding: \$1 billion
- Funding Commitment: \$474 million, with breakdown as follows:

Remaining Funding Commitment: \$526 million, expected to enable the Fund to continue its operation until 2025-26

Over \$25.1 million earned by 96 projects/ventures





Secured matching fund of \$36.5 million and investment, donation and sponsorship of \$17 million
